2. Am I safe to drive if my alcohol breathalyzer shows that I'm under the legal limit?

Absolutely Not. Breathalyzers are for informational purposes only and there is no acceptable level of alcohol consumption that makes it safe to drive. Any alcohol that enters a person's body can impair reflexes, motor skills, and cognitive abilities.

3. Does it comes with mouthpieces?

Yes, it comes with 10 mouthpieces.

4. Can we calibrate alcohol tester by ourselves? Does it comes with spare sensors?

You can calibrate it if you have calibration equipment, there is no spare sensors.

5. What is calibration interval? Once a year or after 1000 times uses.
